Nailekhanim Foundation Scholarship

For the academic year 2022-2023, the Nailekhanim Foundation offered a high-profile competition-based full scholarship for a gifted female student, regardless of national background and citizenship.

On November 11, 2022 the presentation of the Nailekhanim scholarship, established by the Nailekhanim Foundation, was held. Female students selected by the Foundation to study at Khazar University between 2022 and 2025 were awarded. As a part of event, the panel discussion on "The role of higher education in empowering women: challenges and opportunities" was held under the moderatorship of Aygün Gardiner. William abi Abdallah, deputy representative of the UN Children's Fund (UNICEF) in Azerbaijan, Rahilya Geibullayeva, head of the Department of Azerbaijani Literature at Baku Slavic University, Vafa Kazdal, vice-rector for Academic Affairs of ADA University, and Gunel Aghabeyli, founder and director of the Azerbaijan Women in Science Youth Organization, took part in the discussion.

The awards to Italian citizen Claudia Palazzo (PhD studies in International Relations) and Indonesian citizen Brilliant Windy Khairunnisa (Master's studies in International Relations and Diplomacy) were introduced by the founder of Khazar University, Chairman of the Board of Directors and Trustees, professor, academician Hamlet Isakhanli, Vladanka Andreyeva, UN Resident Coordinator in the Republic

of Azerbaijan, and Indra Agustini, First Secretary of the Indonesian Embassy in Azerbaijan.

Nailekhanim Foundation Scholarship

In addition, Khazar University provides the following **need-based scholarships:**

- in case if one or both parents work at Khazar University
- in case if 2 (two) or more students from one family are studying at Khazar University
- students from the Martyr family
- students from the families of disabled from the Karabagh war
- in case of the loss of both parents
- if a student has lost one of his / her parents while studying

Khazar University supports students with excellent academic performance from all over the world to study at Khazar University. "Excellence scholarship" covers the full tuition fee of international students, enabling them to study tuition-free at Khazar University. The merit scholarship covers cover 75%, 50%, or 25% of the tuition fee. Meanwhile, University provides successful master and PhD students with an opportunity to teach and earn monthly salary to cover their basic needs.

All students from low-income countries enrolled to Khazar University in the academic year 2022-23 received university's scholarship.



SDG 2 Zero Hunger

Khazar University is dedicated to SDG2, Zero Hunger, with a commitment to ending hunger, ensuring food security, improving nutrition, and promoting sustainable agriculture.

Research

The 3rd International Conference on "One Health: Problems and Solutions," held on June 1-2, 2023, at Khazar University, addressed key challenges related to SDG 2 Zero Hunger, focusing on climate change, food security, and public health. The conference, organized in collaboration with global institutions, emphasized the impact of climate change on food systems, sustainable agriculture, and integrated health strategies to ensure safe, nutritious food for all. Keynote speakers from the USA, China, and other countries highlighted the importance of international cooperation in tackling food insecurity. The event also showcased student contributions on ecosystem health and sustainable food practices. Overall, the conference promoted global efforts to enhance food security and resilience in the face of climate change.

Khazar University is dedicated to advancing SDG3 through a multidisciplinary approach. The university is committed to generating value in the field of healthcare by producing scientific advancements, offering

innovative solutions, and disseminating knowledge.

Raising Awareness through Series of Seminars Dedicated to the Dight Against Drug Addiction

In January-May 2023, Psychology Department of Khazar University and the Republican Narcology Center, organized seminars on "Harmful effects of the use of psychoactive substances" for students majoring in various disciplines. The main goal of the seminars is to make students aware of the dangers of the effects of psychoactive substances on human health. Along with the harms of the use of psychoactive substances, attention was also paid to increasing the general level of knowledge of students on this issue. Issues discussed included the socio-economic and family problems of young people and the negative consequences of an unfavourable social environment. Students were also provided with information on how to protect their mental and physical health and alternative ways.

Research Collaboration

In the academic year 2022-23, Khazar University's Psychology Department in collaboration with the University of Silesia in Katowice, Poland, and the University of Gdansk, Poland conducted a joint research project that delves into the influence of macro-, meso-, and micro-level factors on work addiction and the resultant health related challenges.

emphasize the need for men to play active roles in advocating for women's rights, supporting the education and personal development of their daughters, and rejecting harmful practices such as early marriage.

The sixth book, dedicated to Sara (Saray) Khatun — Azerbaijan's first female diplomat—celebrates her influential role in diplomacy during the 15th century, showcasing her successful negotiations with regional powers such as the Ottomans and her efforts in fostering peace. By bringing visibility to pioneering women like Sara Khatun, Khazar University promotes the empowerment and recognition of women, aligning with SDG 5's focus on achieving gender equality and empowering women and girls. The book not only preserves cultural heritage but also inspires future generations to acknowledge and celebrate the contributions of women in leadership and diplomacy.

Research

In the year 2022-23, the Environmental Research Center at Khazar University, under the guidance of Abbasov, Karimov, and Jafarova published the research results

Training Sessions on Enhancing Energy Efficiency and Promoting Clean Energy Practices

On November 5, 2022, Khazar University hosted training sessions for local industries and entrepreneurs aimed at

enhancing energy efficiency and promoting clean energy practices. The event's goal was to raise public awareness and support for 100% renewable energy beyond the university.

During the event, action plans were presented to boost energy efficiency and encourage the adoption of clean energy practices. Industries and entrepreneurs attending the training got insights on strategies to minimize energy consumption. In the end, a mutual agreement was reached between the companies and the university, establishing a commitment to ongoing collaboration in the transition to 100% renewable energy.

Seminar on Future Energy Source: lithium and research of lithium minerals in Azerbaijan

On November 29, 2022, the department of Physics and Electronics organized a scientific seminar titled Future Energy Source: Lithium and Research of Lithium Minerals in Azerbaijan. The seminar addressed the ecological benefits of renewable energy as an alternative to traditional sources, stressing the importance of researching renewable energy origins, efficient usage methods, and environmental impacts. Additionally, the discussion highlighted the significance of lithium-based batteries as a promising solution for future energy needs, aligning with the global transition toward sustainable and eco-friendly energy alternatives.

Natural Resources for Sustainable Development Multi-mode Course

The Eurasia Extractive Industries Knowledge Hub affiliated to Khazar University continued to offer the "Natural Resources for Sustainable Development" course in the 2022-23 academic year. Designed as a multi-mode program, this comprehensive course provided a strong foundation in the theories and practices essential for effective resource governance. The program's overarching goal was to foster robust dialogue about global best practices and their applicability to countries in the region, thereby promoting valuable insights and lessons for sustainable development.

Research on Affordable and Clean Energy

An analysis of research outcomes revealed that Khazar University researchers contributed approximately 25 % of the research outputs linked to Sustainable Development Goal 7.

Lecturer of the Department of Political Sciences and Philosophy of Khazar University Dr. Farid Guliyev's article "Renewable Energy Targets and Policies in Traditional Oil-Producing Countries: A Comparison of Azerbaijan and Kazakhstan" was published in "Journal of Eurasian Studies" (2023, Vol. 0 (0) 1-15).

In 2022, the textbook "Introduction to the use of renewable energy resources" coauthored by Rovshan Abbasov, head of the Geography and Environment Department, was published with the financial assistance of BP.

Curriculum

More than 80% of the courses offered by the School of Economics and Management incorporate Principles of Responsible Management Education, which are actively disseminated throughout the university.

Research

An analysis of research outcomes indicates that approximately 30% of Khazar University's research outputs are linked to Sustainable Development Goal 8. Researchers at the university focus on areas such as development models for resource-rich countries, macroeconomic policy frameworks for oil-rich nations, the resource curse, economic diversification, poverty reduction, migration, and sustainable development.

Education, Research and Cooperation on Climate Change

Khazar University has demonstrated a strong commitment to addressing climate change through

education, research, and collaboration. In the academic year 2022-23, as the host of the 3rd International Conference on "One Health: Problems and Solutions," Khazar University provided a platform for global experts to discuss the intersections of climate change, health, and food safety, fostering interdisciplinary dialogue on solutions to environmental challenges. The university's Department of Geography and Environment, led by Dr. Rovshan Abbasov, actively contributes to research on climate change impacts, while students from the Architecture and Design department promote environmental awareness through initiatives like poster presentations on ecosystem health. By engaging in projects like the joint animal welfare and sustainability initiative with the Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences (SLU) and establishing a partnership with Shenzhen University's School of Medicine, Khazar University is advancing climate-focused academic and practical efforts. This commitment positions the university as a key player in regional and international efforts to mitigate the effects of climate change and foster sustainable development.

Preventing Plastic Pollution through the campus's Waste Management Policy

Khazar University is dedicated to reducing plastic pollution in the Caspian Sea through its "zero waste-to

landfill" policy. This commitment will be realized by reducing the usage of unnecessary single-use plastic items and disposables on its campuses.

Research on Perceptions of Animal Welfare in the Regions

On September 1-4, 2022, within the framework of the project, Javid Ojagi, associate professor of the Khazar University Life Sciences Department and Ayaz Mammadov, Ph.D. in Biology, coordinator of Veterinary Medicine, Associate Professor Mahammad Eldarov, deputy dean of the Graduate School of Science, Art and Technology visit Ganja city, Neftchala, Barda and Agjabadi regions.

The main purpose of the visit was to conduct a survey among modern farmers operating in the field of animal husbandry in those regions to learn about the perceptions of animal welfare.

During the visit, the welfare of animals and existing problems were discussed with the heads of fisheries, poultry, livestock farms managed by modern technologies in the mentioned areas.

Policy to Ensure that Food on Campus is Sustainably Farmed

In 2022, a policy was developed and approved to guarantee that food on campus is sustainably sourced. It serves as a framework to ensure that food and beverages are 20 produced, acquired, consumed, and disposed of in a manner that prioritizes environmental conservation, societal well-being, and animal welfare.

Research

Khazar University actively contributes to Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 15: Life on Land through its initiatives in soil science and environmental sustainability. By co-organizing the international conference "Soil Science: Yesterday, Today, and Tomorrow" alongside the Institute of Soil Science and Agrochemistry on December 5, 2022, Khazar University has fostered significant dialogue on soil health, land degradation, and sustainable land use. This event, held on "World Soil Day," brought together experts to address the pressing challenges of soil degradation, land reclamation, and ecological mapping, emphasizing sustainable solutions for land and water resource management in Azerbaijan. Through these efforts, Khazar University promotes knowledge-sharing and research focused on preserving terrestrial ecosystems, combating desertification, and improving land productivity—core aspects of SDG 15.
