In addition to scholarships, Khazar University also recognizes and rewards outstanding student achievements. On June 4, 2024, an awards ceremony was held to honor students who successfully represented the university in national and international events and projects. The event was attended by the university's founder and Chairman of the Board of Directors and Trustees, Prof. Acad. Hamlet Isakhanli; Rector Assoc. Prof. Irada Khalilova; Vice Rector for Administration and Student Affairs, Isakhan Isakhanli; as well as faculty deans, university staff, and students.

In addition, Khazar University provides **need-based scholarships** in the following cases:

- when one or both parents are employed at Khazar University
- when two or more siblings from the same family are studying at Khazar University
- for students from martyr families
- for students from families of veterans or individuals disabled as a result of the Karabakh war
- in the event of the loss of both parents
- if a student loses one of their parents during their studies

In addition to need-based support, Khazar University attracts high-achieving students globally through its Excellence Scholarship, which fully covers the tuition fees of outstanding international applicants. The university also awards merit-based scholarships covering 75%, 50%, or 25% of tuition fees. Furthermore, academically successful

master's and PhD students have the opportunity to engage in teaching activities and receive a monthly salary to support their living expenses.

Khazar University also takes timely action to address the challenges faced by its **Education Grant recipients**. On January 12, 2024, the International Relations Office organized a meeting with scholarship students to discuss their academic and social concerns and to identify appropriate support measures.

Khazar University also supports its student community by empowering financially and socially sustainable startups through relevant education, mentorship, and resource provision. One notable example is the **NextKhazar Idea Show** — an innovation-driven startup initiative designed to build a supportive ecosystem for the development of impactful entrepreneurial ideas.

At the final event of the Idea Show, the following outstanding projects were recognized:

1st place: *Mahsa Javan and Deniz Zareian (Iran)* — for exploring the use of Urmia Lake algosomes as sustainable delivery systems for anticancer and antibacterial agents.

2nd place: *Aygun Mursadova (Azerbaijan)* — for "Green Sphere," an AI-integrated solution using eco-friendly biomaterials to address environmental challenges.

3rd place: *Shafa Yusifova (Azerbaijan)* — for "Shafa's Class," an educational platform designed to make biomaterials science more accessible to learners.

4th place: *Salar Hooshyar and Mehrnoosh Nemati (USA)* — for developing a promising hydrogel aimed at promoting tissue regeneration and angiogenesis for advanced wound care.

On May 1–2, 2024, Khazar University students participated at the "GreenTech" Azerbaijan Startup and Green Technologies Competition. The University was represented by chemical engineering students Turan Huseynzadeh, Leyla Yusifzadeh, and Javidan Shukurov, who are currently in their 2nd and 3rd years of study. Competing among 66 teams, they successfully secured a cash prize of 200 AZN. At the conclusion of the event, the organizing partner, AzerSun company, presented additional gifts to the participants.

On March 30, 2024, the final event of the "Smart Solutions" incubation program, funded by the Innovation and Digital Development Agency under the Ministry of Digital Development and Transport, was successfully organized by the Khazar University Development Center. The winning teams of the program were announced as follows:

1st Place — ECWA (Express Connection with an Ambulance Device) Afat Ahmadova, Shafa Yusifova, and Aisha Bashirli — senior Chemistry-Biology students at Khazar University — secured first place and were awarded a prize of **3,000 AZN**.

2nd Place — Medappoint (Medical Appointment App) The second-place award of 2,000 AZN was presented to a team consisting of Khazar University master's students in Computer

Systems and Networks — Yusif Oruclu, Ugur Huseynli, Fatima Alizade, and Roya Yusifbeyli — alongside Roya Yusifbeyli, a third-year Journalism student at Baku State University.

Khazar University also ensures that students are well supported in preparing for professional life by offering targeted training sessions and workshops designed to enhance their understanding of the labor market and connect them with relevant industry stakeholders.

For example, on **June 11, 2024**, Khazar University hosted "AccessBank Day" for senior students majoring in Computer Science and Computer Engineering. During the session, the Education and Development Manager at AccessBank provided an overview of the bank's operations, mission, and strategic objectives. Students were also informed about the **IT Summer School program** and the bank's recruitment procedures. A Business Partnership Specialist from AccessBank further delivered a practical session covering recruitment strategies, career planning, personal branding, CV writing, interview preparation, and common interview questions.





On September 30, 2024, the University organized a meeting between a representative of the **Education Student Credit Fund** and first-year fee-paying students of Khazar University. The representative talked about issues such as the initial conditions for granting education student loans, stages, and advantages of loan terms, inviting students to take advantage of these opportunities.

Good Health and Wellbeing

Khazar University actively supports SDG 3 by promoting health and well-being through scientific research, innovation, and community engagement.

The University contributes to healthcare advancement by developing innovative solutions, conducting interdisciplinary research, and raising public awareness through educational programs and outreach initiatives.

Health Education & Awareness

On May 25th, 2024, the Psychology Department of Khazar University organized a guest lecture to raise awareness about autism. The guest speaker was Tammie Lenert, an expert in autism and occupational therapist, who is part of the CHED course (Child Health, Education, Development) developed through a joint initiative of the UAFA organization and the Child and Human Development Center at Georgetown University, USA. The event was initiated by a pedagogue-psychologist and lecturer at the Department of Psychology at Khazar University.

On September 8, 2024, a staff member of the Psychology Department at Khazar University and psychologist at the Khazar Psychological Service Center, conducted a

seminar on "Modern Approaches to Schizophrenia" with organization of the General Union to Youth for Support (GUYS) at the office of so-called union. The main purpose of organizing the seminar was to educate young people about schizophrenia and to raise awareness against stigma and discrimination towards those suffering from this illness in society (Seminar on "Modern Approaches to Schizophrenia" - NEWS-Khazar University).

On October 15, 2024, a seminar on "Biopsychosocial Approach to Substance Addiction" was held at Khazar University, organized jointly by the Psychology Department and Psychology Club. The seminar was conducted by a staff member of Khazar University's Psychology Department and psychologist at the Khazar Psychological Service Center. The main purpose of the seminar was to take a preventive step against the widespread occurrence of substance addiction among young people by drawing attention to the harmful effects of substance addiction, which is widespread globally.

Participants received comprehensive information on recognizing early warning signs of suicide risk, maintaining emotional health, and accessing available support mechanisms.

Mental Health and Social Well-being

On March 4, 2024, a seminar titled "Early marriage and its consequences" was held under the joint organization of the Khazar University Psychology Department and the Psychology Club. A graduate of Azerbaijan Medical University and Nova Medical University (Portugal, Lisbon), was invited to the seminar. In her speech, she gave extensive information about the harms of early marriage to the development and lives of young people, the rights of young people who are forced into early marriage, and the institutions they can apply for. During the seminar, opinions were exchanged, many questions of the students were answered.

On October 16, 2024, an informative lesson on Mediation was held at Khazar University for third-year psychology students. Mediation specialist Gasim Shaliyev was invited as a guest lecturer. Gasim Shaliyev addressed not only the legal but also the psychological aspects of mediation, explaining what tools parties can use to better understand each other.

The project's aim is to increase digital learning resources for youth organizations and young people in Azerbaijan by collaborating with experienced organizations from Visegrad countries. The mentor's goal is to raise awareness about mental health issues in Azerbaijan and to take initiative in improving individuals' psychological and emotional well-being (Employee of the Psychology Department became a mentor

in an international project - NEWS-Khazar University).

On October 20–22, representatives from universities along the Belt and Road Initiative, including Khazar University, Al-Farabi Kazakh National University, Asfendiyarov National Medical University, Nazarbayev University, Marat Ospanov West Kazakhstan Medical University, and Samarkand State Medical University, participated in the Shenzhen Forum organized by Shenzhen Medical School in Shenzhen, China. The forum focused on three themes: Medical Science and Technology Innovation Plan, International Medical Education Cooperation, and the Innovation of Ethnic Medicine. The aim was to establish technological exchange platforms, including joint laboratories between the Shenzhen University Medical School and universities along the Belt and Road. Khazar University was represented by the rector, Assoc. Prof. Irada Khalilova at the forum. 

- **3rd place:** *Shafa Yusifova (Azerbaijan)* for "Shafa's Class," an educational platform designed to make biomaterials science more accessible to learners.
- 4th place: Salar Hooshyar and Mehrnoosh Nemati (USA) for developing a promising hydrogel aimed at promoting tissue regeneration and angiogenesis for advanced wound care.



Khazar University, one of the leading higher education institutions in Azerbaijan, is implementing a consistent and purposeful environmental policy across all its campuses. In line with global climate goals, Khazar University has set an ambitious target to achieve net-zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050. In 2024, Khazar University continued to advance its "zero waste-to-landfill" vision with several enhanced actions targeting plastic pollution and waste reduction. The main objectives of the plastic reduction initiative, as outlined in the *Policy on a Plastic-Free Campus* (Policy on Plastic-Free Campus.pdf), are as follows:

- To organize educational events and training workshops that raise awareness about the negative impacts of single-use plastics on the environment and human health.
- To prohibit the use of single-use plastic items within all university premises.
- To install water dispensers across campuses to reduce the purchase and consumption of disposable plastic water bottles.
- To inform and encourage students to use sustainable alternatives to plastic products—such as reusable bottles and cloth bags—within campus facilities.
- To promote and host events that foster the design and creation of ecological and environmentally friendly products as substitutes for single-use plastics.

Water quality standards:

Water quality standards and recommendations are developed to specify acceptable amounts of various components in water to preserve human health, environment, and animals. These standards are frequently established by governmental or regulatory institutions and serve as guidelines for water quality management (Water quality standards and guidelines.pdf).

Biodiversity Conservation Policy

Biodiversity Conservation Policy ensures that Khazar University recognizes the value of biodiversity protection and is dedicated to identifying, monitoring, and preserving species on the IUCN Red List and national conservation lists whose habitats may be damaged by university operations
