

Professor Ertugrul Koroğlu - graduated from Hacettepe University, Faculty of Medicine in 1982. He entered the doctoral program in pharmacology within the civil service program. He then continued his career as a researcher and lecturer in the Department of Psychiatry at Gazi University School of Medicine. From 1988 to 1989, he worked as an Associate Professor at the Huston Baylor College of Medicine, in the US, at the Psychiatric division researching Clinical Psychiatry, Sleep Physiology and Disorders. In 1991, he became an Associate Professor and a Professor at the age of 39 and worked as the head of the Department and Dean of the Kocaeli University School of Medicine. He is an authorized instructor of Motivational interviewing, which takes a special place in the treatment of addiction. After completing the REP-certified psychotherapy training program at the American Albert Ellis Institute of Psychotherapy in New York, he became an internationally recognized supervisor in Turkey. He has participated in the Beck Institute for Psychotherapy in Philadelphia, and the dialectical behavioral therapy programs at the Linehan Institute. He continues his training programs in Turkey. He has established the well-equipped substance abuse treatment center in Turkey, Boylam Psychiatric Hospital. At the same time, he continues to work at the Boylam Institute of Psychiatry. He has been assigned by the American Psychiatric Association as an International Fellow for his success in the field of psychiatry. He is a member of the American Society for Behavioral and Cognitive Therapy. He is also a member of the European Society of Behavioral and Cognitive Therapies and a member of the board of Turkey.
