Course description	The study of this subject by the student enables them to comprehend and assimilate the artistic and technical processes that have occurred in the history of art and industrial design, from the Renaissance to the modern era. The taught materials reflect the history of art and design from various countries and periods within an artistic-technical context. Additionally, one of the main objectives of the art history course is to study existing facts, artistic styles, schools, and the works of individual artists, technologists, and designers.				
Course objectives	<p>The aim of the subject is to provide knowledge about the main stages, artistic characteristics, and the works of key figures in the history of world fine arts and industrial design, starting from the 16th century. The course offers comprehensive knowledge on artistic movements and trends, technical achievements, production lines, monuments, and art samples in the history of fine arts and industrial design, as well as the creative work of individual artists. Theoretical problems in art, auxiliary sciences related to art, and the classification of fine arts, including theoretical categories such as style, school, movement, and group, are explored. The diversity of cultures and their respective artistic manifestations are examined. The development of global painting, sculpture, and graphic art is covered alongside the characteristics of architecture and decorative-applied arts. Students studying this subject should gain knowledge and information about the history of fine arts and design, and be able to analyze the artistic styles, schools, and movements that have existed in various historical stages.</p> <p>Additionally, students are expected to prepare reports on the topics covered and be able to answer the teacher's questions.</p>

Rules (Teaching policy and conduct	<p>Presentation</p> <p>Throughout the semester, students will be taught by the instructor based on presentation materials in sessions lasting two double hours per week. Students are expected to prepare assignments individually or in groups and present them during class. Depending on the content, assignments will be required in the form of a PowerPoint presentation. Before the midterm exam, the presentation assignment is worth 10 points, and before the final exam, the presentation assignment is worth 10 points. It is mandatory that the student personally presents and reads their assignment. The aim of this assignment is to help future art teachers develop and improve their presentation skills and the ability to conduct brief research in a short period.</p> <p>Duration</p> <p>Presentations must be submitted during November and December, after the midterm exam. No additional time is given for presentations after the last lesson week. Each student is allocated 10-15 minutes for their presentation. Students can select the date of their presentation based on their readiness, with a maximum of five students per day. From December onwards, a schedule for presentations will be drawn up.</p> <p>Note: Presentations should be prepared using PowerPoint. Students must create a folder in the Microsoft Teams group for the course under their name and upload their presentation there. Plagiarized work will not be accepted.</p> <p>Quizzes</p> <p>The first presentation assignment is scheduled before the midterm exam in November (10 points), and the second is before the final exam in December (15 points). Both quizzes will involve presentation assignments. The purpose of the quizzes is to reinforce knowledge on the covered topics and help students prepare for answering open-ended questions in exams.</p> <p>Exception: If a student has notified the faculty dean in advance about their inability to participate in the presentation due to valid reasons (family issues, health), or has provided documentation (application or reference) afterward, they may be allowed to retake the quiz.</p> <p>Attendance</p> <p>The maximum score for attendance is 5 points. A student is awarded 5 points if they attend all the lessons for the course during the semester. If the total number of missed hours exceeds the normative 25% (due to illness, family issues, etc.), the student will not be allowed to take the exam and will be subject to a decision regarding their case.</p>		

	<p>Examinations</p> <p>The midterm exam will be in test form, covering topics taught in September and October. The final exam will also be in test form, covering topics taught in November and December. All issues related to a student's participation or absence from the exams will be resolved by the faculty administration.</p> <p>Completion of the Course</p> <p>A student's knowledge will be evaluated on a scale of 100 points. To pass the course, a student must achieve an overall success rate of 60% or higher. A student who fails may retake the course in the next semester or academic year.</p> <p>Violation of Exam Rules</p> <p>Students are prohibited from disrupting the exam or engaging in cheating during the midterm and final exams. Failure to adhere to this rule will result in the annulment of the student's exam and a score of 0 (zero).</p> <p>Student Conduct Rules</p> <p>Students are not permitted to violate the University's internal discipline regulations or use mobile phones.</p>
