Course outline	This course covers general principles of the tourism law, including rules on entry-exit to Azerbaijan, passport control, types of passports, identity cards, visa obtaining process, rights and obligations of the tourists in Azerbaijan Republic and rights and obligations of the Azerbaijani citizens abroad. Course also includes general information about relative fields of law, such as constitutional law (law adoption process), corporate law (company law), contract law (different types of contracts) and etc.		
Course objectives	This course is addressed to non-law students and gives them opportunity to study general principles of tourism law environment that affects individuals and legal entities. The course provides the student with foundational information about legal system and main rights/obligations in field of tourism law. The major content areas will include general principles of rules on entry-exit to Azerbaijan Republic, passport control, visa obtaining process, of law, and other law-related issues in the global and local context.

Policy	<p>Attendance and activity: The students are required to attend all classes as part of their studies and those having legitimate reasons for absence (illness, family bereavement etc) are required to inform the instructor.
