Course outline	<p>This course is designed for Bachelor students.</p> <p>Examines problems encountered in employability; the role of synergy between employers and educators; the role of internships and related programs in developing employability qualities; the expectations of employers; and models of employability. The course will be based on employability model - Career Edge- developed by Dacres Pool and Sewell (2007: 208).</p> <p>It will follow the parts of the mentioned model such as career planning, role of academic knowledge in successful career building, as well as other skills (communication, presentation, time management, IT skills, analytical skills, etc.). Students will be provided sufficient knowledge about the necessity of volunteering and internship programs. During the course, the students will gain information about Emotional intelligence theory developed by Daniel Goleman. Students will be provided strategies that support positive attitude to work. Moreover, Financial literacy and its contribution to successful career and individuals` wellbeing. Social responsibilities and ethical organizational behaviors are other values that students will discuss during the class.</p>
