During each class, **group discussions** will be carried out to encourage students discuss their own version of written translation of social-political texts from English into Azerbaijan and vice versa and discuss challenges they face during written translation. Students will be given handouts in advance so that they can get themselves familiarized with the materials to be translated.

**Attendance** is required for the entire course for the student to receive credit. Partial attendance is considered as an absence and will affect the final grade. Excessive absence, more than <u>25 percent</u>, will result in a failure of the course. Activity: During each class, group discussions will be carried out to encourage students discuss their own version of written translation of texts from English into Azerbaijan and vice versa and discuss challenges they face during written translation. Students will be given handouts in advance. For the **project work**, students will be asked to present a presentation in a given topic. Deadline for submitting the projects will be defined later. For mid-term exam, students will be given one short text (in Azerbaijani, or in English) to translate as well as they will be asked to complete the vocabulary task.

For the Final exam, Students will be given one short text (in Azerbaijani, or in English) to translate as well as they will be asked to complete the vocabulary task.

A student is normally expected to achieve a mark of at least 60% to pass. In case of failure, he/she will be required to repeat the course the following term or year.
