### **Course Description**

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The purpose of this course is to provide an introduction to mental disorders in adult humans. We will discuss diagnostic issues and methods used to study psychopathology. We will also examine a variety of mental disorders from several different theoretical and treatment perspectives. Focus will be on diagnosis, epidemiology, course of the disorder, etiology, and treatment issues. We will also briefly examine ethical and legal issues pertaining to psychopathology. A major goal of the course is to promote greater awareness and knowledge of psychopathology in hopes that we can reduce the suffering and stigma associated with mental disorders.

### **Course Objectives**

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- a) to provide students with an integrative overview of the field of psychopathology, major psychological problems and disorders.
- (b) to familiarize students with the multiple causes of psychopathology as viewed from a number of different theoretical perspectives.
- (c) to illustrate principles of the psychotherapy for different problems and to teach students about the existence of different psychotherapy methods.
- (d) to provide an integrative view of research in the area of psychopathology.
- (e) to promote critical thinking skills in the area of psychopathology.

### **Movie Review Assignment**

Films often contain characters that exhibit psychological disorders and/or altered mental states. Your assignment is to:

- Watch a popular film that depicts a character with some form of psychological disorder covered in this course.
- Analyze how the content of the movie relates to course material on psychological disorders (see specific questions below).
- Present your video and diagnosis to the class in a 5- to 10-minute presentation. You must show one scene (example) from your movie during your presentation.

Your report must be:

- 12-point font. Maximum 2-3 pages, single-spaced

After watching your movie, answer the following questions:

1. What mental/psychological disorder is portrayed in the movie?
2. How does the movie relate to the course material covered in class or in your textbook? Please discuss at least four specific scenes and clarify how the movie and course material are related. This should be the main part of your report. You may point out how the movie illustrated course material and/or how it was not in accordance with what you have learned in this class.
3. Provide the full details of your diagnosis of the character, including the signs and symptoms apparent in the film, and relate them to the criteria for the disorder in the DSM-V.
4. Discuss the best forms of treatment for this person and the prognosis.
5. How has watching the movie contributed to your understanding of psychological disorders and their treatment? I don't have to agree with your opinions, but you will be graded on showing an understanding of course material and the issues involved.

## **Response Paper/Presentation**

Find a new research work from Google Scholar regarding some kind of psychological disorder. Write down a summary on the highlights of the research work you read.

1. What is the research question?
2. What is the hypothesis?
3. What kind of methodology did they use?
4. What are the main results?
5. Conclusions, implications, and future directions

Your report must be:

- 12-point font. Maximum 2-3 pages, single-spaced

Present the research work in a 5–10-minute presentation to the class.
